International Classes: All horses entered in these classes must be registered with the PHAA or APHA. Copy of PHAA or APHA registration certificate must accompany entries.

Futurity Prizemoney: Jackpot after 10% kept for Admin. This will be worked out at 50% 30% 20% 10% and all classes to be awarded to 4th place.

Ribbons to sixth place - Trophies where applicable.

- ❖ Prize money paid to third place where five or more horses in a class.
- ❖ Prize money paid to second place where three or four horses in a class.
- ❖ Prize money paid to first place where one or two horses in a class.

Walk and Jog is to be ridden to age of horse. i.e. Senior horse in a curb and single handed.

- Entrants that ride in Walk and Jog do not enter any open or Amateur classes – eg. open or amateur hunter undersaddle.



Rules to be adhered by....

- ❖ Dogs must be on a lead at all times. Any dog found running loose will be impounded.
- ❖ All horses must be yarded at night in their allocated yards.
- ❖ Steel portable pens may be used during daytime for mares, geldings, and stallions.
- ❖ Horses tied to trucks or floats must be under supervision.
- ❖ *Manure and waste hay must be put in the skip provided.*
- ❖ All stallions must be supervised when not in their yards or pens.
- ❖ Youth may not ride or be in control of a stallion at any time during the show.
- ❖ Any person under the influence of drink or drugs may be asked to leave the show area.
- ❖ All owners and competitors must be financial members of PHANZ Inc.
 - (A non-member may show a horse in hand/halter and pay a day fee of \$10)
- ❖ **All competitors must produce horse registration papers on demand. Failure to produce same will result in disqualification. The show committee reserves the right to inspect any horse's registration papers and brands.**
- ❖ **This is a closed breed show. All horses must be permanently registered before applying for entry.**
- ❖ As this show is a closed breed show, additional breeds/colour of any kind will not be allowed on any day during this show. Manes may be banded on Halter and Western Performance days and braided on English day.
- ❖ The PHANZ Inc and co-sponsoring organisations, if any, will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to or be caused by any horse at the show, or for any article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or in any way damaged.
- ❖ Halter classes will be run under the PHANZ Inc breed halter rules.
- ❖ Western performance classes will be run under the NZWRF rules.
- ❖ English performance classes will be run under the ESNZ rules.
- ❖ **Amateur Riders** must have attached a copy of their Amateur card with their Entries.
- ❖ An Amateur Card can be acquired through the NZWRF for \$5 to be able to compete in the classes. Conditions Apply.
- ❖ **Youth may nominate one horse only** for each different sector to be counted for High Points Awards.:
i.e. Western Performance, Games & English
- ❖ Date of arrival must be stated on entry form for the arrangement of facilities.
- ❖ English competitors will have a gear safety check before the jumping events.
- ❖ All riders must wear ESNZ approved hard hats in all speed events.
- ❖ All refunds less 20% admin. Vet or doctor's certificate required within seven days of the event.
- ❖ The Show Committee reserves the right to alter or amend this schedule depending on entry numbers and conditions.
- ❖ **Points on Computer numbers** ~ Horses 'registered' with the NZWRF must enter using their registered number, which must be used in every event. These can be obtained from the NZWRF for approx \$5 plus postage.
- ❖ **Horses without NZWRF numbers will be allocated a PHANZ number. A \$2 refundable deposit must be paid for each number with your entries.**
- ❖ **Competitors please note – All classes entered on a horse must be on the same form regardless of handler/rider.**
- ❖ **NZRHA Rules**
- ❖ **First Year Novice Reining:** for those competitors in their first competitive year of reining, must not have competed in an Open, Aged, Amateur or Senior Youth event in previous seasons.
May have competed in Rookie or Junior Youth reining in previous or current season.
- ❖ **Open Novice Reining:** for those competitors whose average score in past Open, Aged or Amateur events has not exceeded 68. Finished horses with novice reiners are eligible for this class providing they fulfill the above criteria.
Horses of any age can be ridden one or two-handed in any bit, so long as the bit is legal to show in.
Competitors can swap between one and two hands during the event.
- ❖ **Walk and Jog** is to be ridden to age of horse. i.e. Senior horse in a curb and single handed.
 - Entrants that ride in Walk and Jog do not enter the open classes – i.e. Open, Rookie or amateur hunter undersaddle.
 - A horse can compete in Walk and Jog and Open as long as it is a different rider.

PLEASE NOTE: The grounds are at the Tauranga racecourse so there are times that the track cannot be crossed before 9am. For most people it will be more ideal to get there the day before.
